

## Consortium Verification Network Glossary

Term	Definition
<b>Consortium</b>	A group of trusted organizations (banks, governmental entities) running the essential Verified.Me distributed network components. Also known as a Blockchain Federation.
<b>Consortium Member</b>	A trusted organization with one or more of the following roles: Digital Asset Provider, Node Operator, Digital Lockbox Provider, Digital Asset Consumer.
<b>Digital Asset Consumer (DAC)</b>	An entity which can request a Digital Asset from a user. Examples are banks, governments (federal, provincial, municipal), health care providers and educational institutions. In general, online service providers who need information about a user.
<b>Digital Asset Provider (DAP)</b>	A trusted authority who has information about a user. Examples are banks, provinces and credit bureaus.
<b>Digital Lockbox Provider (aka Service Host)</b>	The organization the user has selected as their home for Verified.Me services.
