TRIRIGA Reporting Version 1.1.25 Release Notes

Compatibility:

TRIRIGA: 10.8+

TRIRIGA Application Platform: 3.8+

Installation/Upgrade Steps:

1. Download the TR 1.1.25 Zip File.
2. Log in to TRIRIGA and navigate to Object Migration.
3. Upload, validate and then import the provided OM Package.
 - a. For current users of previous versions of TRIRIGA Reporting there are NO post-OM manual steps required to upgrade to 1.1.25.

New Features:

- **Conditional Formatting:** Highlight cells with certain colors depending on the cell's value WITHOUT needing to use a Custom Column Function.
- **Excel Export Enhancement:** Excel exports include a date/time stamp within the file name
- **New Graph Filter Types for Dates:** On or Before and On or After Filter Types added for Date fields
- **Auto-Expanded Column Labels in Pivot Mode:** A simple enhancement helps for better user readability when using pivot mode in a report.
- **Recycling Custom Column Names:** A deleted Custom Column name label can now be used again when you create a new Custom Column!
- **Under the Hood Upgrades:** Additional tweaks to features and functionality that make the app better, fix hidden bugs, and improve user experience. A full list of the bugs resolved is available [here](#).
- **Minor UI Enhancements:** Data Setting Hover Descriptions - more optimal placement on the screen for readability

- **Query Filters: Date and Datetime compatibility updates**

TRIRIGA Application Platform: 4.0+

- New UI for time picker on datetime fields
- Query filtering on date and datetime fields are now functional for all formats with the exception of the following two:
 - dd-MM-yyyy HH'h'MM'min' —> 'After' and 'Before' are the only filter types working
 - MMMM dd, yyyy hh:mm a zzz —> Doesn't work for any filter type

Platforms Below 4

- 'Equals' and 'Not Equals' Query filters are not functional on any date time formats
- The following formats work with 'Before', 'After', 'On and Before', 'On and After'
 - dd-MM-yyyy HH'h'mm'min'
 - yyyy/MM/dd HH:mm a zzz

Known Limitations

- TRIRIGA Reporting is not currently configured to use localized data.
- Custom column field type: adjusting the field type after the column has been created presents a visual bug in which the values do not auto update to the new type. Simply refresh your page to see the changes.
 - Investigation is on-going.
- Single quotations (') or double quotations (") in the query name will cause an issue when trying to pull the query into TRIRIGA Reporting.
 - Suggestion: Remove these characters in the query name
- Query Filters: query filters cannot be created on fields from Smart Sections or from BOs other than the Primary.
 - Requires TRIRIGA enhancement.
- The 'Service Request' License does not meet the license requirements to use TRIRIGA Reporting
 - If you want your users in this license to have TR access, then you will need to grant a higher license
