## Release Highlights

IBM is pleased to introduce IBM webMethods Adapter 7.1 for X.400. Built on top of IBM webMethods Trading Networks and IBM webMethods Integration Server, IBM webMethods Adapter for X.400 provides simple adapter services to communicate with X.400 servers to send and receive mail. X.400 is a popular set of email standards specified by the ITU-TS (International Telecommunications Union - Telecommunication Standard Sector), popular in Europe and Canada. The X.400 standard provides detailed specifications for message handling systems and services for message exchange. Implemented as an Integration Server Gateway Service, the IBM webMethods Adapter for X.400 provides a way for IBM webMethods Trading Networks to communicate with X.400 servers using ADDONMAIL UA-FI communication software.

The IBM webMethods Adapter 7.1 for X.400 includes the following features:

- **Send and Receive X.400 Messages**  
The adapter provides services to send and receive interpersonal messages as well as X.435 EDI messages. The services work in conjunction with the Integration Server scheduler to periodically receive and send messages:
  - Receive delivery and non-delivery notifications.
  - Receive receipt and non-receipt notifications.
  - Receive correlation document.
  - Send delivery notifications and EDI specific administrative advisories.
