Based in Ulm, Germany, family-owned group SCHWENK Zement KG manufactures cement and construction concrete for the building industry. With products sold primarily in Germany and Namibia, as well as in parts of Europe, SCHWENK employs about 3,150 people and generated annual revenues of around EUR800 million (approximately USD917 million) in 2013.

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## High performance guaranteed at all times

SCHWENK Zement KG primarily focuses on the German market and is steadily building out its customer base, selling cement and other specialized construction materials. SCHWENK also opened a factory in Namibia – the first cement works in the country – creating an African export hub offering huge potential opportunities for the company.

SCHWENK relies on integrated SAP applications to run almost every aspect of its business operations, and SAP ERP and SAP Business Warehouse solutions deliver a unified overview of production, procurement and delivery processes.

Andreas Nischwitz, System Manager System z at SCHWENK, elaborates: “In recent years, additional growth in the use of SAP applications has put increasing pressure on our systems. Driven by our international expansion into Namibia and the implementation of new applications, such as SAP Customer Relationship Management for our sales teams with the SAP CRM Sales mobile app, we found that on too many occasions the systems were unavailable, perhaps due to outages or necessary maintenance.”

He continues: “For SCHWENK to meet stringent internal service-level agreements, as well as production and delivery targets, it is critical that systems run round the clock, no matter what. It became clear that we needed to re-evaluate our IT environment to secure continued high performance and staff productivity at existing business units, as well as ensuring that we could cope with business growth.”

## Solid foundation for quick-moving business

SCHWENK was using IBM DB2 databases on IBM z Systems™ in combination with IBM Systems Storage® technology to run its SAP landscape. Based on this experience of the impressive reliability, availability and scalability of the IBM solutions, SCHWENK decided to upgrade to an IBM zEnterprise BC12 server with IBM DB2® for z/OS® to support its mission-critical SAP ERP, SAP CRM and SAP Business Warehouse applications and ensure business operations.

For improved business continuity, SCHWENK deployed two IBM System Storage DS8870 solutions at geographically separated data centers, and implemented IBM MetroMirror to provide synchronous long-distance data copies.



Working closely with IBM Global Technology Services®, SCHWENK completed the database migration of its SAP ERP applications and new SAP CRM instance quickly and easily, with minimal impact on end-users or the business.

SCHWENK deployed IBM FlashCopy for quick data backup, using the IBM Systems Storage TS7740 Virtualization Engine and IBM Systems Storage TS3500 Tape Library solutions for long-term archiving with IBM enterprise tape technology. To ensure that SCHWENK could recover operations even in the highly unlikely event of server hardware outage, the company teamed with IBM Global Technology Services to establish a cost-efficient recovery plan. In the event of disaster, SCHWENK can recover operational data quickly and resume full operations.

## Building block for future expansion

With its core business areas growing steadily, it is important that SCHWENK is able to manage increased business volumes easily and cost-effectively – and the scalability of the IBM z Systems plays a key role for the company.

Andreas Nischwitz remarks:

“IBM z Systems with IBM z/OS offers excellent performance, absolute reliability and tremendous scalability.
