At a glance

IBM^(R) Data Privacy Passports V1.0 is designed to provide Z data protection functionality by enabling expanded coverage across the entire enterprise and is engineered to deliver these core capabilities:

- Extends data security capability that encompasses data-at-rest and data-in-motion.
- Protects structured data at the core of the enterprise and may help simplify compliance management in an environment of expanding regulation and requirements.
- Enables privacy in an open world with granular controls around data usage.

Overview

As digital technologies advance and the data explosion continues, the risk of security breaches grows. However, organizations have a need to share important data across internal business units that may not share the same privacy protocols or policies.

To help satisfy this need, IBM delivers Data Privacy Passports V1.0. IBM Z^(R) takes the next step of the data protection journey on IBM z15TM and LinuxONE III servers by extending data protection. Through policy enforcement, this protection stays with the data when it moves beyond the system of record and into distributed and hybrid cloud environments. The Data Privacy Passports offering provides a data-centric security solution that will enable data to play an active role in its own protection. These capabilities are designed so that clients can more easily:

- Manage regulatory compliance.
- Remove the complexity of key management.
- Strengthen their hybrid enterprise with IBM Z encryption.

- An IBM z15 server or an IBM LinuxONE III server
- An LPAR with either:

- Four IBM Integrated Facility for Linux[®] (IFL) processors, 128 GB of memory, and 128 GB of disk storage, or
- Eight IBM IFL processors, 256 GB of memory, and 256 GB of disk storage
- IBM Hyper Protect Virtual Servers V1.2 (5737-I09)

Description

Data Privacy Passports:

- Extends IBM security leadership by helping to protect data beyond the system of record with data security capability that encompasses data-at-rest and data-in-motion states.

As data leaves the system of record, use the new Data Privacy Passports offering to protect sensitive personal information in the distributed copy of the data. Through policy enforcement, this protection stays with the data when it moves beyond the system of record and into distributed and hybrid cloud environments. This helps eliminate the possibility that someone could make copies from copies and create a larger potential for information to be exposed, either intentionally or accidentally, compared to using other techniques.

- Protects structured data at the core of the enterprise and may help simplify compliance management in an environment of expanding regulation and requirements.

When there is a reason to view the sensitive information, the user can come back to Data Privacy Passports that, by policy, provides a view of that data for that user. This view could be clear, redacted, or using other obscuring techniques, depending on the policy configuration. The transaction is logged so that a data access can be tracked across the enterprise.

- Enables privacy in an open world with granular controls around data usage.

Sensitive data in the enterprise is protected through encryption and access to this data with Data Privacy Passports can be removed, either dynamically through policy, or by deleting the encryption key.
