RosettaNet is an industry-wide, global business standard used by Electronic Components, Semiconductor, and Information Technology companies. It provides consistent messaging guidelines to enable them to exchange B2B transactions with their trading partners.

standards that define the packaging, routing and transport of exchanging PIP messages – and supports all versions of PIP. Trading partners of all sizes can connect electronically to easily process RosettaNet transactions and move business data within their supply chain.
