

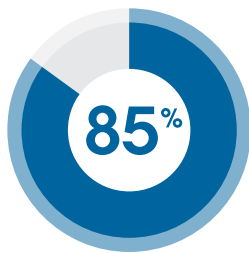

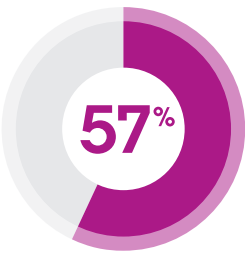
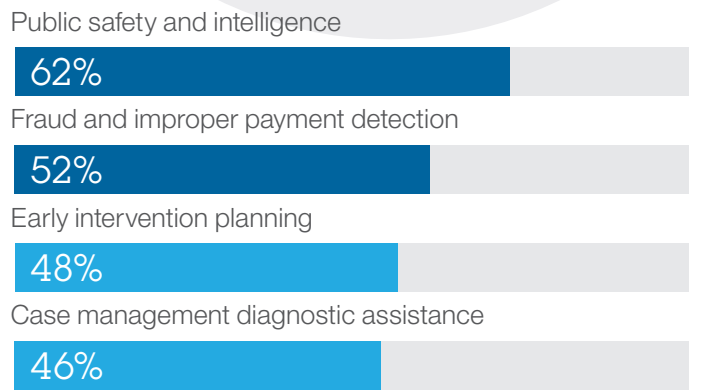


Opportunities

45% Lack of skilled resources and technical expertise



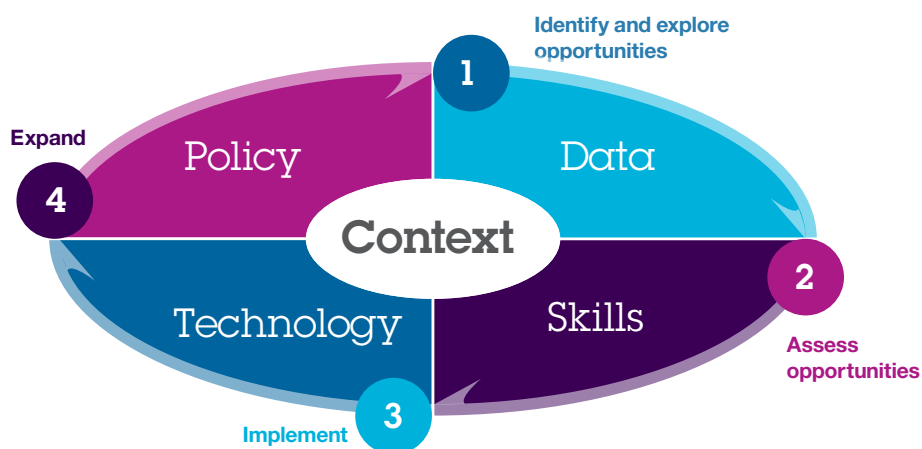
36% Legal, security and privacy concerns
