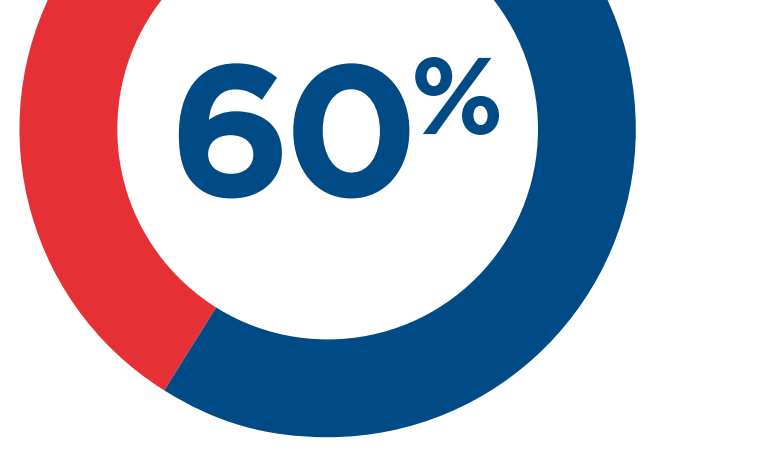

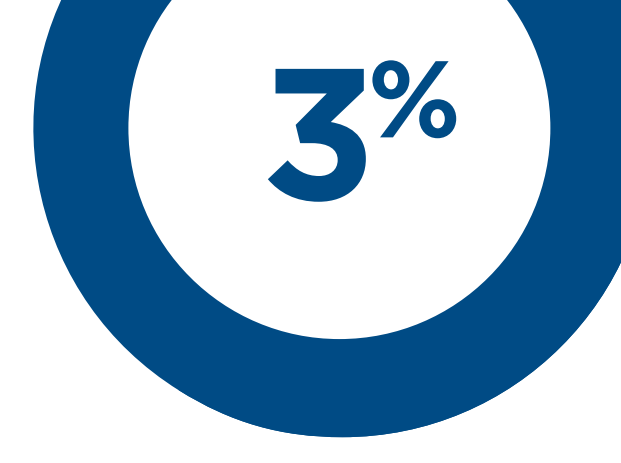
Invest in digital expertise

Cloud Is the New Business Imperative

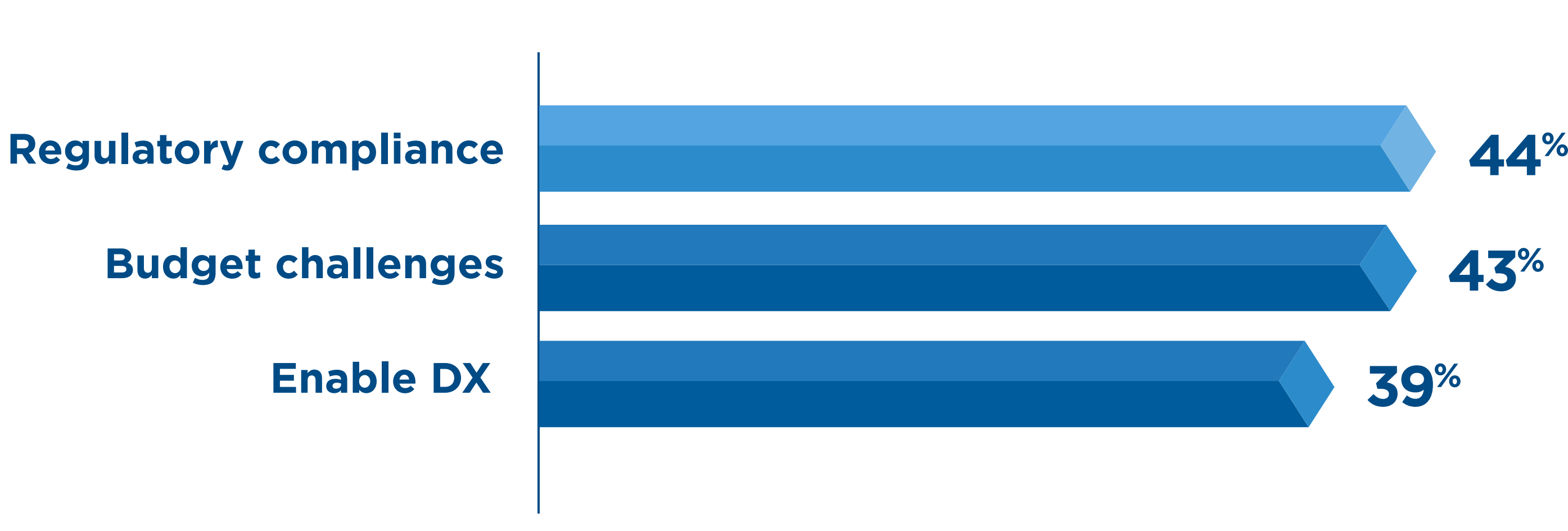


60% of enterprises are proceeding as planned or investing more in cloud services in 2020.

Top 3 Reasons to Adopt Cloud Services



Less than 20% of enterprise workloads have moved to cloud. However, over 60% of organizations in Canada are planning to implement a hybrid or distributed cloud environment over the next 12 to 24 months.

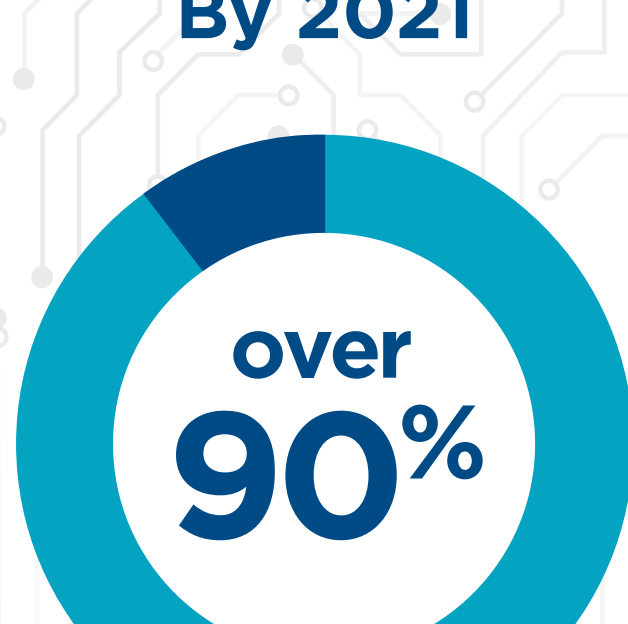

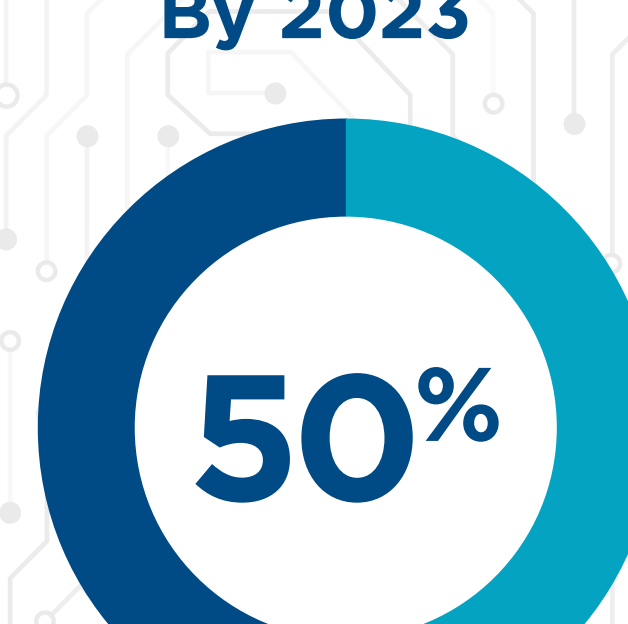
