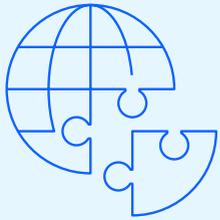

Sustainability at IBM

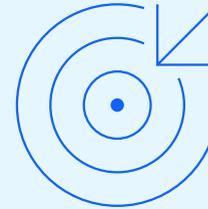
