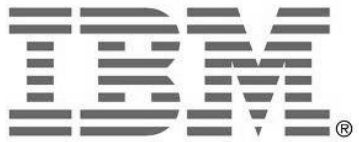

This Interim Fix updates the IBM® OpenPages® with Watson™ environment from version 8.2.0.4 or previous 8.2.0.4.x interim Fix to 8.2.0.4 IF2 on Red Hat Enterprise Linux® (RHEL) or Microsoft™ Windows™

Installation Tasks

To install IBM® OpenPages® with Watson™ 8.2.0.4 IF2, perform the following tasks.

Task 1: Ensure that all OpenPages servers and services are running except the Global Search server

Note: For details, see the “Starting and stopping servers” chapter in the *IBM® OpenPages® with Watson™ Administrator’s Guide*

Task 2: Apply the OpenPages 8.2.0.4 IF2

Use the 8.2.0.4 OpenPages installer to apply the 8.2.0.4.2 Interim fix. Perform the following steps as the user that setup the Installation Server.

Using the installation app, do the following:

- 2.1 Ensure that the OpenPages 8.2.0.4 installation server is running and that the OpenPages 8.2.0.4 installer agents on the remote servers in the deployment (if applicable) are also running.
- 2.2 Copy the **openpages_interimFix_8-2-0-4-2.zip** file from the interim fix kit into the `<InstallerMaintenance>` directory on the installation server.
- 2.3 Open the existing 8.2.0.4 deployment and press the browser’s **Refresh** button to refresh the installation app.
- 2.4 Click the `Deployment Task` drop-down and select `Interim Fix` and select `8.2.0.4.2` in the `Version` drop-down.

Perform the **Validate**, **Install**, and **Configure** actions to apply the interim fix updates to the OpenPages 8.2.0.4.x deployment.

Note: Each file in the OpenPages deployment that is replaced by the interim fix content is automatically backed up into the `<OPBackup8204>`, `<CCBackup8204>`, or `<OPSearchBackup8204>` folder, as applicable.

Task 3: Stop and Restart all OpenPages servers and services

- When restarting the OpenPages application servers, use the `--clean` option

For example

```
./startAllServer.sh --clean
```

- When restarting the `IBMOpenPagesFrameworkModelGenerator` service, use the `--clean` option.

For example

```
./server start IBMOpenPagesFrameworkModelGenerator --clean
```

Uninstalling this Patch

Uninstalling 8.2.0.4 IF2 will revert the system to the previous patch level.

To uninstall IBM® OpenPages® with Watson™ 8.2.0.4 IF2, perform the following tasks as the user that setup the Installation server.

Task 1: Stop all OpenPages servers and services

Note: For details, see the “Starting and stopping servers” chapter in the *IBM® OpenPages® with Watson™ Administrator’s Guide*.

Task 2: Manually restore the previous patch version from the backups

Manually restore the previous OpenPages patch level from the <OPBackup8204>, <CCBackup8204>, or <OPSearchBackup8204> directories created during the 8.2.0.4.2 interim fix installation, as applicable.

Note: Make sure to use the backup directory that reflects the previously installed OpenPages patch level. Restoring to a patch level that is not the previously installed patch level is not supported.

Application Servers

On each Application Server, do the following

- 2.1 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/applications directory.
- 2.2 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/applications directory:
 - op-apps.ear
- 2.3 Navigate to the <OP_APP_Home> directory.
- 2.4 Copy the following files from the <OPBackup8204>/wlp-usr/shared/apps/op-apps.ear directory:
 - aurora.jar
 - aurora-tools.jar
 - opappsosaupdate.jar
 - opappbase.jar
 - reporting.jar
 - com.ibm.openpages.env.comparison.jar
- 2.5 Navigate to the <OP_APP_Home>/sosa.war/WEB-INF/lib directory
- 2.6 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/wlp-usr/shared/apps/op-apps.ear/sosa.war/WEB-INF/lib directory:
 - opappcommon.jar
- 2.7 Navigate to the <OP_APP_Home>/sosa.war/META-INF directory
- 2.8 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/wlp-usr/shared/apps/op-apps.ear/sosa.war/META-INF directory:
 - MANIFEST.MF
- 2.9 Navigate to the <OP_APP_Home>/publishweb.war/WEB-INF/lib directory

- 2.10 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/wlp-usr/shared/apps/op-apps.ear/publishweb.war/WEB-INF/lib directory.
- opappcommon.jar
- 2.11 Navigate to the <OP_APP_Home>/publishweb.war/META-INF directory
- 2.12 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/wlp-usr/shared/apps/op-apps.ear/publishweb.war/META-INF directory.
- MANIFEST.MF
- 2.13 Navigate to the <OP_APP_Home>/taskui.war/META-INF directory
- 2.14 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/wlp-usr/shared/apps/op-apps.ear/taskui.war/META-INF directory.
- MANIFEST.MF
- 2.15 Navigate to the <OP_APP_Home>/META-INF directory
- 2.16 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/wlp-usr/shared/apps/op-apps.ear/META-INF directory.
- MANIFEST.MF
- 2.17 Navigate to the <OP_APP_Home> directory
- 2.18 Delete the following files
- log4j-api-2.17.0.jar
 - log4j-core-2.17.0.jar
 - log4j-jcl-2.17.0.jar
 - log4j-jul-2.17.0.jar
 - log4j-slf4j-impl-2.17.0.jar
- 2.19 Copy all the log4j files from the <OPBackup8204>/wlp-usr/shared/apps/op-apps.ear directory.
- 2.20 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/bin directory.
- 2.21 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/bin directory:
- QuestionnaireUtility.cmd
 - QuestionnaireUtility.sh
 - RpsRpf.cmd
 - RpsRpf.sh
 - NotificationManager.sh
 - NotificationManager.cmd
 - ObjectManager.cmd
 - ObjectManager.sh
 - chng-sys-password.cmd
 - chng-sys-password.sh
 - UpdatePasswordEncryptionAlgorithm.cmd
 - UpdatePasswordEncryptionAlgorithm.sh
- 2.22 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/lib directory
- 2.23 Delete the following files
- log4j-api-2.17.0.jar
 - log4j-core-2.17.0.jar
 - log4j-slf4j-impl-2.17.0.jar

- 2.24 Copy all the log4j files from the <OPBackup8204>/lib directory
- 2.25 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/aurora/bin/compare_environments directory
- 2.26 Delete the following files
- log4j-api-2.17.0.jar
 - log4j-core-2.17.0.jar
 - log4j-slf4j-impl-2.17.0.jar
- 2.27 Copy all the log4j files from the <OPBackup8204>/aurora/bin/compare_environments directory
- 2.28 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/aurora/bin/compare_environments directory
- 2.29 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/aurora/bin/compare_environments directory
- com.ibm.openpages.env.comparison.jar
- 2.30 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/aurora/op-ext-lib directory
- 2.31 Delete the following file
- log4j-1.2-api-2.17.0.jar
- 2.32 Copy the log4j file from the <OPBackup8204>/aurora/op-ext-lib directory
- 2.33 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/aurora/conf directory
- 2.34 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/aurora/conf directory:
- versioninfo.txt
- 2.35 Navigate to the <OP_Home> /Notices directory.
- 2.36 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/Notices directory:
- Notices.doc
- 2.37 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/license directory.
- 2.38 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204>/license directory:
- notices
- 2.39 Navigate to the <OP_Home> directory.
- 2.40 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8204> directory:
- openpagesregistry.xml

Reporting Servers

On each Reporting Server, do the following

- 2.1 Navigate to the
<CC_Home>/wlp/usr/servers/IBMOpenPagesFrameworkModelGenerator/apps/crf-
refresher.war/WEB-INF/lib/ directory.
- 2.2 Delete the following files
- log4j-api-2.17.0.jar

- log4j-core-2.17.0.jar
- log4j-jcl-2.17.0.jar
- log4j-jul-2.17.0.jar

2.3 Copy all the log4j files as well as the following files from the

<CCBackup8204>/wlp/usr/servers/IBMOpenPagesFrameworkModelGenerator/apps/crf
-refresher.war/WEB-INF/lib/ directory.

- aurora-tools.jar
- reporting.jar

2.4 Navigate to the <CC_Home>/temp/p2pd directory

2.5 Copy the following file from the <CCBackup8204>/temp/p2pd directory

- aurora-tools.jar

2.6 Navigate to the <cognos_home>/webapps/p2pd/WEB-INF/lib directory

**2.7 Copy the following file from the <CCBackup8204>/COGNOS/webapps/p2pd/WEB-INF/lib
directory**

- aurora-tools.jar

2.8 Navigate to the <CC_Home>/license directory.

2.9 Copy the following file from the <CCBackup8204>/license directory:

- notices

2.10 Navigate to the <CC_Home> directory.

2.11 Copy the following file from the <CCBackup8204> directory:

- openpagesregistry.xml

Global Search Server

On the Global Search Server, do the following

2.1 Navigate to the <OPSearch_Home> /opsearchtools directory.

2.2 Copy the following file from the <OPSearchBackup8204>/opsearchtools directory:

- opsearchtool.jar

2.3 Navigate to the <OPSearch_Home> /Notices directory.

2.4 Copy the following file from the <OPSearchBackup8204>/Notices directory:

- Notices.doc

2.5 Navigate to the <OPSearch_Home> directory.

2.6 Copy the following file from the <OPSearchBackup8204> directory:

- openpagesregistry.xml
