Oracle Database 19c Now Certified with E-Business Suite 12.2 for Linux on IBM Z servers!

This Flash describes the availability of Oracle Database 19c now certified with Oracle E-Business Suite Release 12.2 (12.2.3 and higher) running Linux[®] on IBM[®] LinuxONE[™] and Z[®] servers as a *'database tier only'* platform.

On December 3, 2019, Oracle announced the certification of E-Business Suite 12.2 with Oracle Database 19c for Linux on IBM Z servers. This is available for the most current on-premises Oracle Database version 19c running Red Hat[®] Enterprise Linux version 7 and SUSE[®] Linux Enterprise Server version 12 for IBM Z servers.

This is a 'database tier only' (also known as a 'split tier' configuration) certification where the application tier must be on a fully certified E-Business Suite platform - see My Oracle Support's certification page for more information. IBM's Z servers fully support a mixed platform architecture with distributed Unix and Linux certified E-Business Suite application tier servers for customers looking to run the Oracle Database tier on IBM Z servers with E-Business Suite.

This announcement underscores Oracle's continuing commitment to deliver new versions of the Oracle Database running Linux on IBM LinuxONE and Z servers. Oracle's announcement can be found at:
