DLC 4.2 integration with GGC 3.1

To ensure the compatibility of DB2 Change Accumulation Tool with DB2 Automation Tool, DB2 Change Accumulation Tool supports the grouping function available in DB2 Automation Tool. This means that groups that are processed in DB2 Automation Tool can be processed in DB2 Change Accumulation Tool without requiring any changes in DB2 Change Accumulation Tool. At build time, DB2 Change Accumulation Tool treats objects that are in multiple groups as if are in a single group.

Panel Changes

There are several panel changes that are introduced with this feature that are visible in DB2 Change Accumulation Tool but which do not apply to DB2 Change Accumulation Tool.

Changes TCz “Product Parameters” panel

The Upgrade DB2 objects for APAR# PI55449 field has been added to the Product Parameters panel. If selected, this option generates the upgrade DDL for an existing installation. For new installations, the DDL that is currently generated already includes the necessary changes. **NOTE:** This APAR introduces changes to the BIND JCL that is generated by TCz.

Changes to GGC\$OPLK, GGC\$UPLK, GGC\$JPLK – Enter Objects/Profiles/Jobs Like to Display panels

There are no longer a popup panels for specifying a matching pattern for objects, utility profiles, or jobs when accessing the DB2 Change Accumulation Tool main menu options for Object Profile, Utility Profile, and Job Profile.

Changes to GGC\$JOPT – Generation Options for *profile.name*

The updated GGC\$JOPT panel, shown below, includes the following options and fields that, although present, **do not apply to DB2 Change Accumulation Tool:**

Messages

The following messages have been changed with this feature:

GGC040E If the End Point is set to "S"pecified, you must enter a valid 12 or 20 digit hex value for the ending RBA/LRSN.

Explanation: You set the End Point to S (specified) so you must also enter a value for the end RBA/LRSN. The end RBA/LRSN value must be a valid 12 or 20 digit hex value.

User Response: Correct the JCL and resubmit the job.

GGC073E If the Restore Before Point is specified, you must enter a valid 12 or 20 digit hex value for the RBA/LRSN.

Explanation: You have specified an invalid value in the Restore Before Point field.

User Response: Specify a valid 12 or 20 digit hexadecimal value in the Restore Before Point field.

GGCM401E This option is only valid when using a version 9 or higher DB2 subsystem.

Explanation: You set an option to a setting that requires DB2 Version 9 or higher.

User Response: Change the option setting to an appropriate setting for your version of DB2.

The following messages have been added with this feature:

GGCM408E The specified data set could not be found in the MVS catalog

Explanation: The specified data set could not be found in the MVS catalog.

User Response: Verify that the data set you specified is correct.

GGCM602E DB2 Autonomic Statistics is only valid for DB2 Version 10 NFM and above

Explanation: DB2 Autonomic Statistics is not valid for your version of DB2.

User Response: Verify that you have the correct version of DB2.

GGCM603E SPRMADMT is missing

Explanation: A component is missing.

User Response: Contact IBM Software Support.

GGCM605W Import successful but the RECOVER RBA/LRSN was not found in SYSCOPY. This value will be discarded.

Explanation: The point-in-time LOG RBA/LRSN and/or RESTOREBEFORE LOG RBA/LRSN values were not found in SYSCOPY. These values will be discarded.

User Response: No action is required.

GGCM618E Invalid RBA/LRSN value. Specify *number* hexadecimal digits.

Explanation: The RBA/LRSN value you specified is not valid.

User Response: Correct the JCL and resubmit the job.

GGCM660E A name of a valid partitioned data set and member name are required

Explanation: The partition data set name and member name are required.

User Response: Specify a valid partitioned data set and member name.

GGCM661E LISTAPARS Job *jobname* successfully submitted.

Explanation: The job was successfully submitted.

User Response: No action is required.

GGCM707E Explain "O"nly is valid for DB2 Version 10 and above. Resetting to blank.

Explanation: The value you specified is not valid for your version of DB2.

User Response: Correct the value.

GGCM709E Utilities cannot be defined on excluded objects.

Explanation: You attempted to define a utility on an excluded object.

User Response: Modify the utility so it does not reference an excluded object.
