Job Role	Definition
Administrator	<p>A Compensation Administrator updates models to reflect changing business requirements is involved in setting-up business events management activities, configures system with business knowledge and configures compensation plans.</p> <p>A System Administrator supports the overall application for organization, understands product architecture and components, is responsible for importing and exporting data to/from IBM Cognos ICM, maintains administrator/end user data, and deals with system integration and automation issues.</p>
Implementer	Builds databases, models or applications for compensation administrators and end users. This can include report development, metadata and ODBC models, building and deployment of repots and dashboards or development of SDK applications.
Report Builder	Builds reports and dashboards for end users by gathering report requirements and creating the reports for distribution.
